

5th Circuit Affirms Vacated Conviction for Robbins Russell Client Kevin Howard

The U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit affirmed the lower court's decision vacating the conviction of Kevin Howard, former Chief Financial Officer of Enron Broadband Services. Mr. Howard had been convicted on five counts, all of which were vacated by the district court. Robbins Russell has represented Mr. Howard in connection with these post-trial proceedings, with Larry Robbins arguing the case before the court of appeals.
